Sunday Homily Tips

The Church celebrates today, the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. God is one but three Persons; and the three persons are: God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. These three Persons are not three Gods but one God. These three Persons are shown very clearly in the second reading when St Paul wrote, “The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.” We profess it when we recite the Creed, when we begin and end the Mass. As Catholics our whole lives are based on the Trinity.



We are called to learn from the Trinity. In the Trinity we see collaboration, not competition, Unity in Diversity and Equality. We are also invited to reflect in our lives these qualities seen in the Trinity – mutual love, solidarity, reciprocity, service, respect, participation and sharing; in this way we become children of the Trinity.
